

Ranch Hand Saddle Bronc Riding Rules

1. All saddles must be western – NO association or association style saddles allowed.
2. All Stirrups and leathers must be for a western saddle. No modified stirrup leathers will be allowed.
3. Cinch and latigo for a western stock saddle.
4. Saddle strings allowed but not braided behind the cantle for a hand hold.
5. Bucking rolls, slick forks or swells will be allowed.
6. There must be a rope strap and lass rope attached in the traditional way.
7. Lass rope may be tied down to the fork of saddle.
8. This event is to be ridden in western stock saddle so that when you get finished with your ride you would be able to go rope a steer in this same saddle.
9. At the discretion of the stock contractor, the “rein” maybe tied to the throat latch of the halter or to the halter ring and then run under the throat latch.
